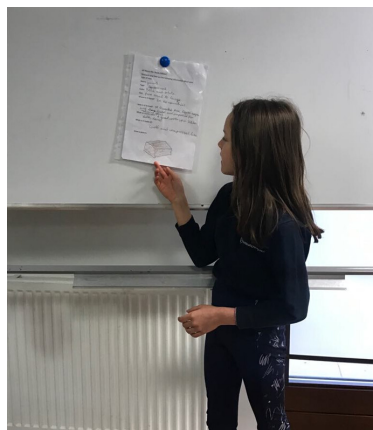

In Language Arts, the students have been reading the novel "The Diary of a Killer Cat" by Anne Fine. After reading Chapter One, the students participated in a chapter study and discussion. The students used a mind map to brainstorm ideas on how to stop Tuffy (the killer cat) from killing other animals. In the Cornerstone book, the students have read comprehension pieces and answered questions about them.

In Mathematics, the students have been learning about multiplication. They have used a multiplication chart to identify different patterns and multiples. The students have also learned to use different strategies to solve problems such as skip counting or mental math. They were also encouraged to justify their answers.

In Science, the students have been learning about rocks. They have created posters to illustrate the different types of rocks. During science class, the students also presented their mini research projects to the class.

In Social Studies, the students have started to learn about communication both in the past and now.
