focused on reducing plastic waste in our oceans. May will take a different turn as we learn about structures!

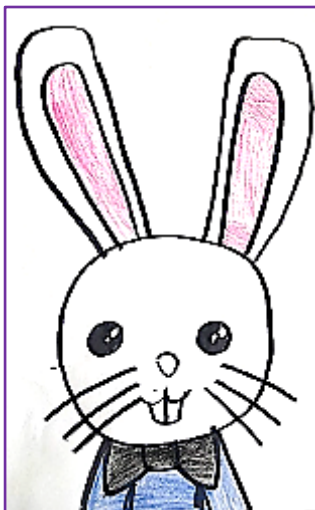
