I hope you had a relaxing Easter break. This month, we introduced the story, *Sue the Tadpole*. We learned some great vocabulary from this story and the kids had fun sequencing the story and matching the pictures to the words. They were able to answer questions about the details of the story as well. We also talked about the fact that Sue the tadpole had to be patient to grow arms and legs just like her parents. We

also learned about different kinds of trees such as deciduous and evergreen trees. They also learned to compare and contrast different items and objects.

In Math, we have been learning to divide numbers using different strategies. A few strategies that we discussed in class are repeated subtraction and making equal groups. We also introduced fact triangles to understand the rela-

tionship between multiplication and division.

In Science, we have been learning about the various types of animals that migrate, and why they do so such as the amazing monarch butterfly. The students also learned about when the monarch's migrate and where they travel to.

In Social Studies, we have been learning about Earth Day. We created an action plan which can be implemented at home. The students have also been learning about Mexico and Brazil!
