In English Language, all of the students have been assessed on sight words and were given a list of their words to practice at home. I will be progress monitoring the students beginning next week (week of 8 March) to see how well they are learning and mastering their words. As they master a list, they will move on to the next level of words. We have completed the alphabet through the letter "T" with five more letters to learn. Also, we have been reading simple sentences, making CVC words within word families, and learning sight words. Every Thursday, the students get on the computer to practice what they have learned via either starfall.com or education.com.

In <u>Mathematics</u>, we worked on addition, subtraction, patterns, and graphs.

In <u>Social Studies</u>, we continue to work on learning the days of the week and the months of the year. We have also started to learn about our bodies. We enjoyed singing the song, "Heads, shoulders, knees, and toes".

In <u>Science</u>, we finished learning about the water cycle. The students should be able to tell you about the cycle (precipitation,

evaporation, and condensation). We enjoyed singing songs about the water cycle and reading books to help our learning.

In <u>Art</u>, we drew and colored many fun things, including a Penrose Triangle which is an optical illusion.
