Introduction...

November was a great month for learning in Grade 1! It was so great, in fact, that I forgot to take any pictures. 😊 It is too bad we had to end the month with a week of online learning.

In English Language, we continued improving our English reading via Cornerstone Reading series and kidsa-z. Every student leveled up on kidsa-z at the end of October, during November, or 1st of December! We started having spelling lessons and quizzes for a grade; the students are doing well learning how to take the quiz! We also learned about common nouns, proper nouns, verbs, and pronouns.

In Mathematics, we worked on learning about fact families, and the addition or subtraction strategies of counting on or counting back. We also learned a math game to let us practice our addition facts called “Around the World”.

In Social Studies, we learned about respect and how we can show respect to others. We also started to learn about geography and geography tools.

In Science, we started to learn about the 5 senses of hearing, sight, touch, taste, and smell. We drew a diagram of the eye and labeled the parts of the eye – pupil, iris, eyelash, eyebrow, and eye lid. When we return from online learning, we are

going to graph the students’ eye colors.

In Art, we finished learning about art from China by making Chinese dragons. We also did a art projects from Art for Kids Hub on YouTube – a cartoon squirrel and a simple autumn project to create fall trees.
