Introduction... Welcome back to another wonderful year of learning and growing together!

In English Language, we are using our Cornerstone Reading materials to improve our reading and understanding of English. Our spelling words each week will come from the story words and the sight words for the story we are reading. We are also using Kids A-Z for reading practice again this year. Kids A-Z is part of www.readinga-z.com and is an online reading program. In addition to kidsa-z.com, we are going to try out IXL.com, another online program I am familiar with as I used it in the US with my students.

In Mathematics, we have been reviewing number sense (ordering numbers, comparing numbers, writing number words, etc.), along with addition and subtraction of 1-digit and 2-digit numbers.

In Social Studies, we have been reading and learning about Marie Skłodowska-Curie. This is in preparation for our Living Wax Museum project. I am still asking for names of famous Poles for the students and their projects.

In Science, we are learning what science is and tools used by scientists. For our first science experiment, we need plastic bottles (500 ml) as we are going to

make “Elephant Toothpaste”.

In Art, we have started learning about color theory: primary, secondary, and tertiary colors, warm and cool colors, and complementary colors. pictures.
