In English Language, we are using our Cornerstone Reading materials to improve our reading and understanding of English. Our spelling words each week will come from the key words and the academic words for the story we are reading. We are also using Kids A-Z for reading practice again this year. Kids A-Z is part of www.readinga-z.com and is an online reading program.

In <u>Mathematics</u>, we have been reviewing number sense (writing number words, rounding numbers. estimating), along with addition and subtraction of 2-digit and 3-digit numbers.

In <u>Social Studies</u>, we have been reading and learning about Marie Skłodowska-Curie. This is in preparation for our Living Wax Museum project. Thank you to Hania's mom who sent me the names of three Polish women. If you have any suggestions, please them to me.
