



Grade 4 October News

Language Arts...

Students have been exploring their way through the novel "Charlotte's Web." Being able to envision a fictional novel from a third person viewpoint. Grammar structures have also been a main focus point for us this month as the students have been mastering the skills of the English grammar and understanding the definitions of a variety of English vocabulary.

Mathematics...

Students have been taking up problems and figuring out how to work around multiplication and division equations. Being able to break down the problems at hand through a logical lens and finding out the solutions by properly structuring a plan of attack.

Science...

Students study weather components: air temperature, atmospheric pressure, wind direction and speed, cloudiness, precipitation and atmospheric sediments. Students also study different types of precipitation and atmospheric sediments.
