Assignments in Class

Grades

- •Grades are on a scale from 1-6, with 6 being a perfect score. "0" is put in for absences only. If a student refuses to complete work, a "BZ" is entered in Librus and the work must be made up during consultations and without the possibility of a perfect score.
- •If your student is absent for an assignment a "0" will be entered as the grade and changed when the student makes up the work.
 - ***Please do this within 2 weeks of the absence, if possible, so there is no rush before the semester ends!
