Language Arts...

October has come to an end and the students are officially done with Unit 1 from the Cornerstone textbook! From Unit 1, the children have learned about saving wild animals and did a group project creating an "Animal Sanctuary". Students have been doing plenty of descriptive writing activities where they describe an animal without mentioning the animal's name and about a place where they've been to while incorporating the five senses.

Math...
