

Grade 5 November Newsletter

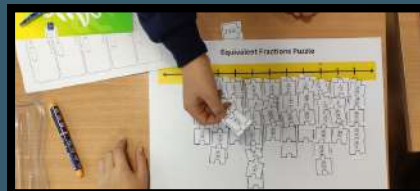


Language Arts...

Grade 5 have been learning how to write dialogues, as well as storytelling by retelling a story from their student edition book. It was quite challenging for them, but they had fun doing it.

Math...

Students reviewed multiplication and division rules, answering many word problems. We have also begun a new unit focused on fractions, decimals and percentages. We are working on solving puzzles in order to practice equivalent fractions.



Science...
