Language Arts...

This month Grade 6 students have been learning how to improve their grammar by adding adverbs and using different types of conjunctions in their sentences. Students have also learned how to use the Past/Present/Future perfect as well as Past/Present/Future perfect continuous in their sentences.

Math...

We continue to tackle the world of fractions and decimals. Students completed projects where they had to solve different types of word problems. We also completed a review in the form of a Football Mania game. Students continue to show their understanding in different ways.

Science...

This month Grade 6 has been learning about different types of invertebrates, like nematodes, flat worms and insects. The students also took a trip to a nearby forest to dig up some flatworms.
