# Grade 6 January Newsletter

#### Language Arts...

As well as practicing spelling words and how to include 4-5 syllable adverbs in their sentences, the students have been learning how to make up their own dialogues from the novel 'Holes' by reading a narrated paragraph and inventing a dialogue scene. (Mostly improvised)













# Math...

Students created geometric snowflakes looking at different shapes: rhombus, rectangle, parallelogram, hexagon, trapezoid, triangle and square. We also review the fractions unit using a jeopardy game and calculated areas of different shapes. Student have also begun drawing Angle Monster, showcasing their skills with a protractor.

# Science...

Grade 6 have been learning about Mollusks. The students have learnt about the different species that live in forests and aquatic environments, what they eat and about their different characteristics.

# History...

We had a short lesson about Martin Luther King Jr. to learn about segregation and the civil rights movement in the Unites States. Students also learned about Baroque architecture and the different parts of buildings that show or resemble this style.
