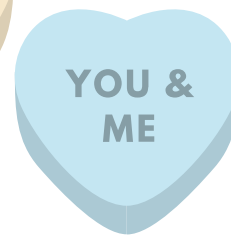


Grade 6 February Newsletter



Language Arts...
