

# Grade 7 March Newsletter

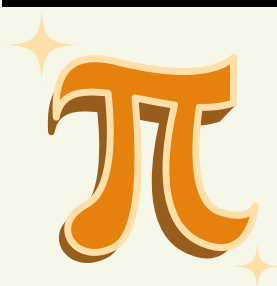
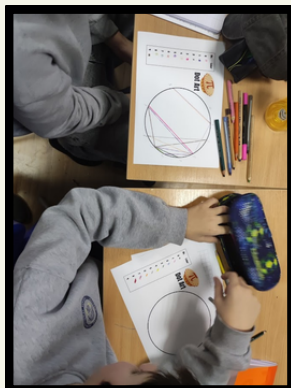


## Language Arts...

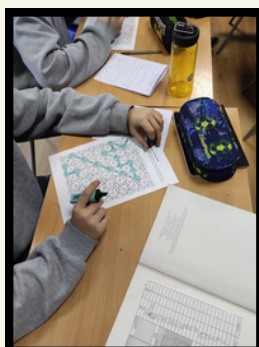
## Math...
