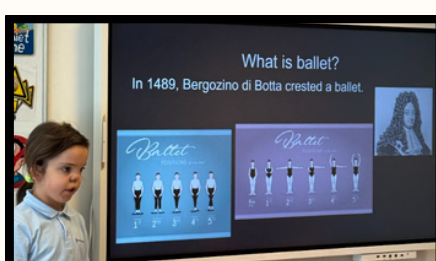
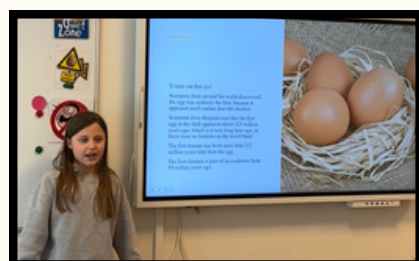


Language Arts...
