Language Arts...

Students worked on preparing for the Speaking Contest both as individual contestants and groups of up to five. We practiced our writing through opinion essays, recommending a book, movie or novel. We finished up the second novel of the semester, A Wrinkle in Time and we continue to work on grammar and spelling skills.

Math...
