Krasnobród – the spa gem of Roztocze. On the outskirts of the Krasnobród commune there is the highest hill of Central Roztocze – Wapielnia (387 m above sea level). The village is located in the Krasnobród Landscape Park and in the vicinity of the Roztocze National Park.

13.30 Workshops at the Beekeeping Incubator in Pszczela Wola.  
The training room is connected to the so-called educational corridor, i.e. a completely glazed corridor running along the production rooms, enabling observation of the work carried out in the incubator.



We'll see:

- Uncapping - removing a thin layer of wax from the frames, under which honey is stored ready for collection
- Centrifugation - when the combs in the hive are full of honey, it is time to spin it from the combs. They are placed in the honey extractor one by one, which is then set in motion.
- Creaming - the process of giving honey a uniform consistency, eliminating palpable lumps from honey
- Decrystallization - the process of decrystallization of bee honey consists in the transformation of barley (solid phase) into patoka (liquid phase) under the influence of heating.
