




Language Arts

The students have been working really hard on writing projects, such as writing their own scripts to stories from their Student Edition, summarizing texts and practicing new vocabulary words like 4-5 syllable adverbs to use in their spelling quizzes.







Math

Students finished up the unit on the areas and perimeters of compound shapes. We began looking at the next unit on integers. Students practiced adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing integers. We looked at factors and multiples and played a domino game.

Science

Students studied the respiratory system and its important parts, like the lungs and trachea. We learned how breathing works and why oxygen is important for the body. Students also debated the topic of organ donation, practicing both science and critical thinking. They shared great ideas and learned from each other.

History
