LANGUAGE ARTS

The students have just started reading 'Stuart Little' which is their 2nd novel for this semester. They have thoroughly enjoyed reading it. The students have also been taking mock tests and practicing the vocabulary words from the Student Edition book to prepare themselves for the Spelling Bee contest.



HISTORY

Students have been learning about Polish history and some of the most famous Polish figures. They are currently researching and creating posters about Maria Skłodowska-Curie. They are learning about her achievements, her education, her contribution to the war effort, how she won the Nobel Prize, and why she was remembered.

MATHS

Students have continued to practice everything they have learned in the first semester and review what has been difficult. They worked in groups to prepare and present a short instructional poster on how to follow the steps and complete a long division problem.
