This month, the students have ideally been focusing on preparing for the speaking contest. They have been working really hard on their topics, researching, designing and practicing their speeches in class.

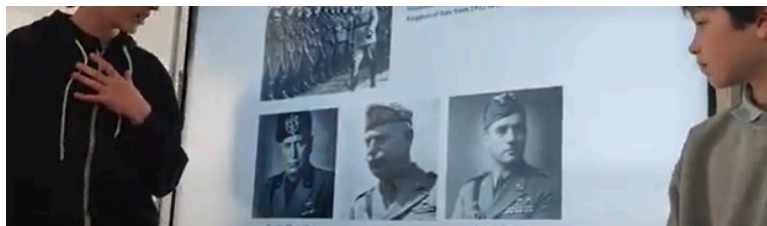
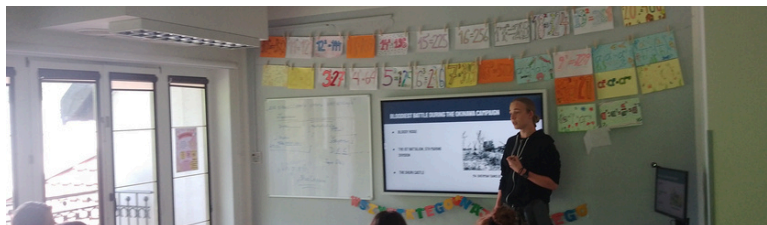
MATHS

Students began looking at the data unit. We learned about both qualitative and quantitative data and about bar graphs, line graphs and pie charts. Students worked on creating their own survey questions, gathering information from their classmates and organizing the information using visuals.



HISTORY

Students worked on creating websites with information about the interwar period. They looked at several key figures: Joseph Stalin, Benito Mussolini, and Adolf Hitler. They also looked at the governments and countries in that time: the USSR, Italy under Fascist rule, and Germany from the Weimar Republic to the Third Reich.



SCIENCE

Grade 7 focused on the main elements in our bodies: carbon, hydrogen, and oxygen. They learned how these tiny parts work together to keep us alive. The class had discussions and small activities to see how important these elements are. It was a good start to understanding bigger science ideas.
