LANGUAGE ARTS

Students are finishing up the last novel, *The Giver*, and showing their understanding by choosing one of two assessment options. They also completed a Letter to the Editor writing assignment, looking at persuasive and argumentative writing. Students are busy working on the speaking contest presentations.

MATHS

Students began looking at ratios, rates and proportions. They are calculating different ratios and learning how to write answers in simplest form in order to show the relationship between two numbers clearly.
