### Language Arts

The students have now moved on to their 4th novel titled 'Danny the Champion of the World'. They've been reading in groups and independently, and verbally summarizing chapters from the book in class. The students also wrote essays about the future, and did group and individual presentations about how transportation, religion, music and education will look in the future.

### Mathematics
