### Language Arts

The students have been having their weekly spelling quizzes and have been reviewing stories from the Student Edition, which includes critically analyzing, questioning and summarizing the text.

Grade 7 students have also started reading 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' which is their 3rd and final novel.

### Mathematics

Students continued to work on the data unit and they analyzed different information and answered comprehension questions based on charts and graphs. They began working on creating a board game that reviews all of the math concepts that they have learned this year.
