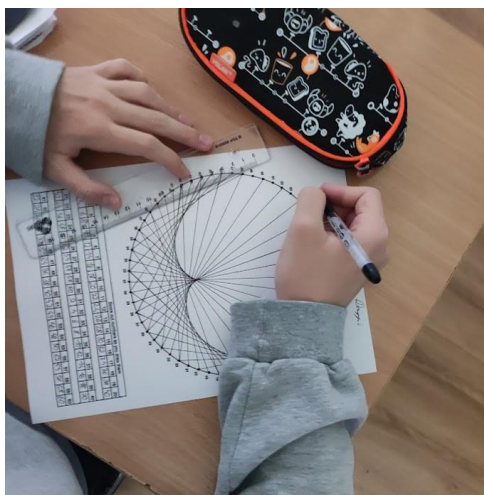
Mathematics
