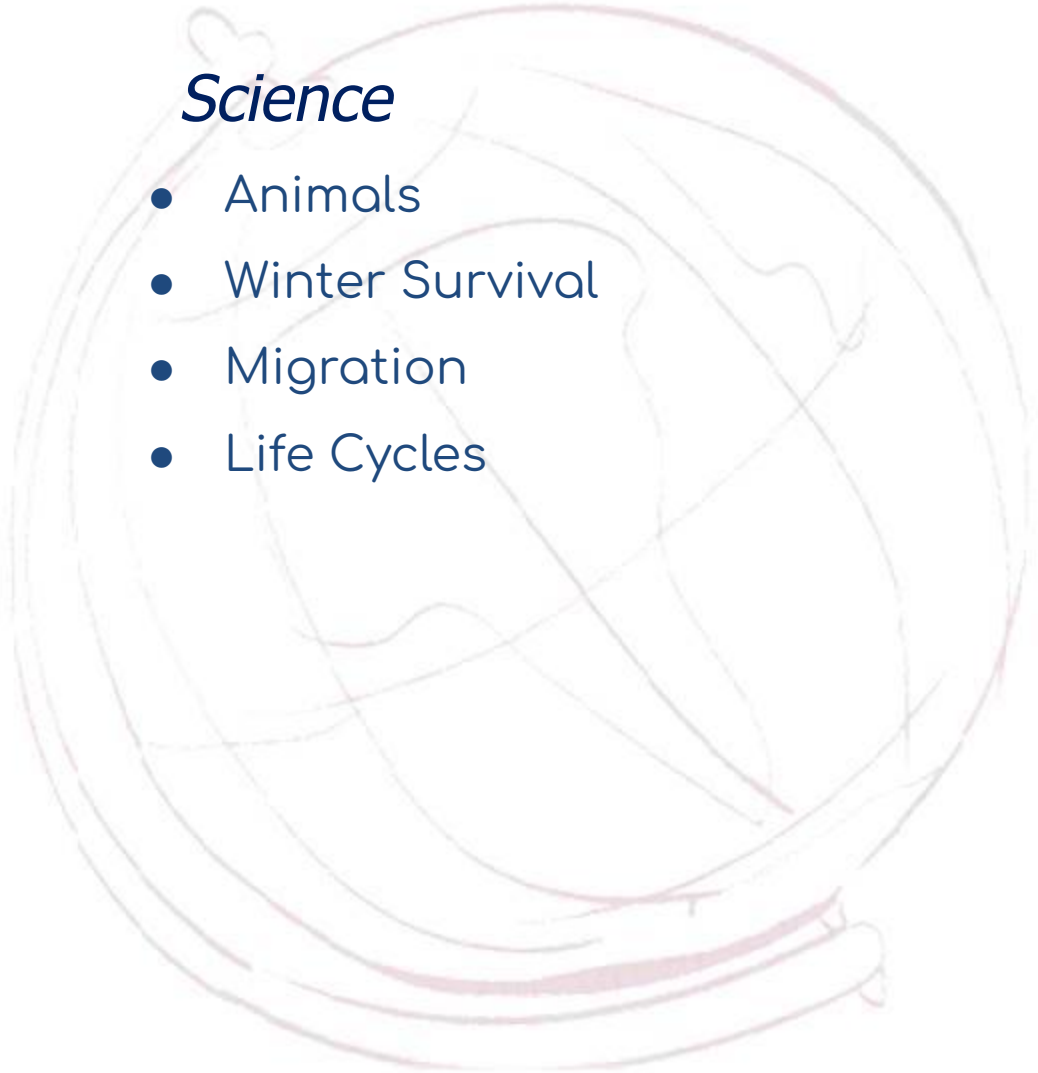

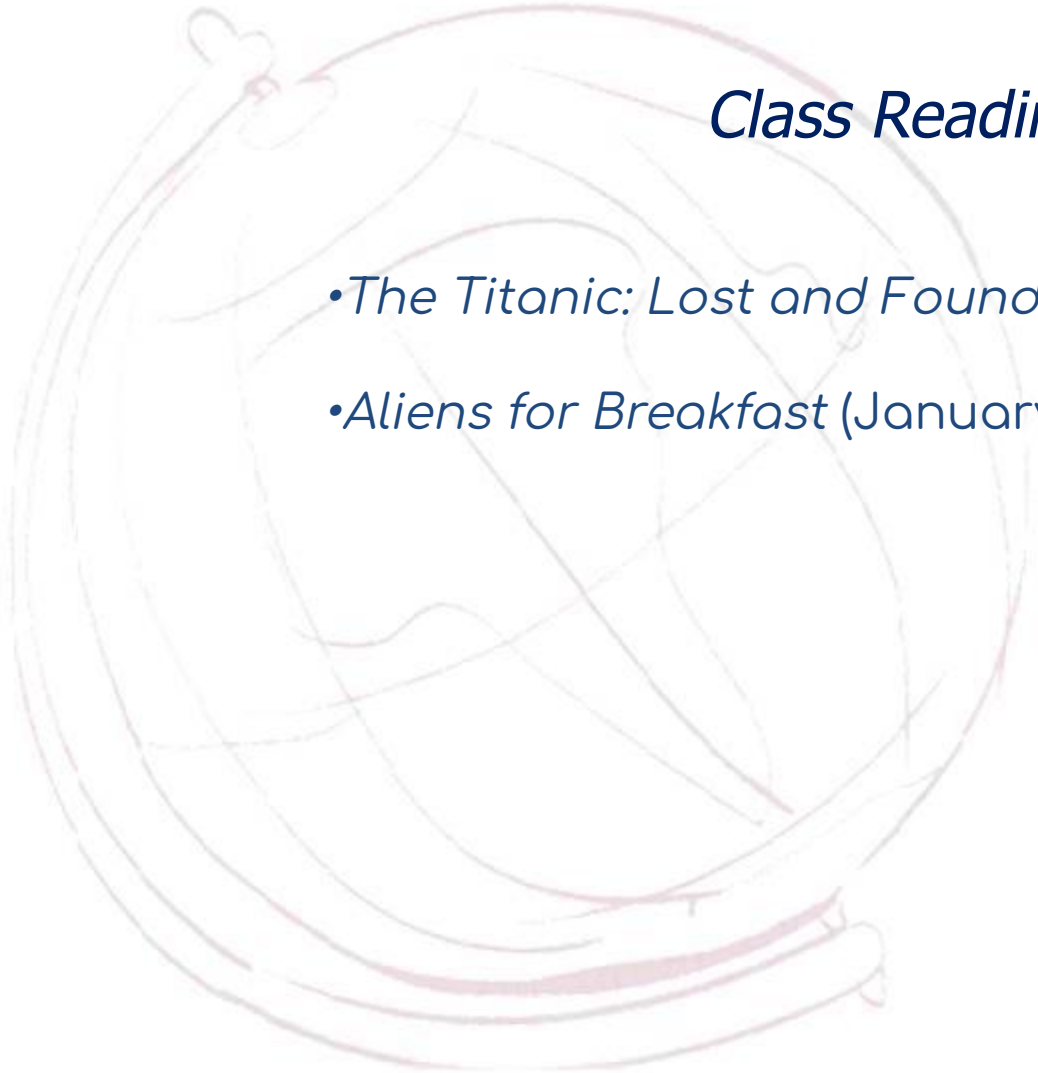

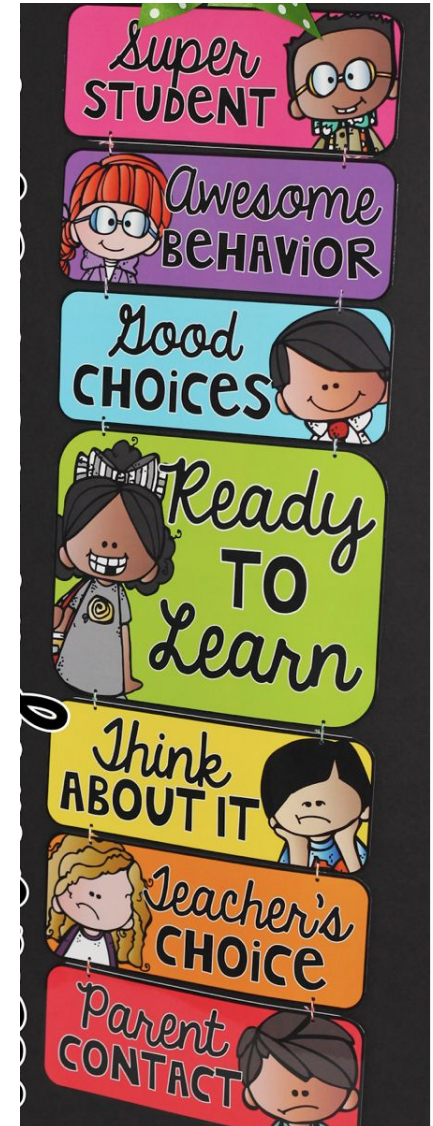

Homework

- Studying for Spelling Quizzes!
- Projects will be worked on both at home and at school.
- If a student is unable to complete work in class in a sufficient time, the work will be sent home. They must return it by the next class in the same subject.

Grading

- Graded work includes, but is not limited to:
 - Cornerstone workbook
 - CCC workbook
 - Digital assignments
 - Presentations
 - Supplemental worksheets
 - Quizzes
- I do not grade work for contests including the Spelling Bee and Speaking Contests.
- Graded work receiving a 5 or below can be retaken during English Consultations. The time for this is Monday mornings at 8am in the Grade 2 classroom

***Please help your students to develop the habit of quickly making up work as soon as possible!

Grading

- A “0” will be given to students who were absent when a graded assignment was given
- A “BZ” will be given if a student did not complete work in a timely manner - usually they have a generous amount of time!
 - E.g.; A project is due, but the student doesn't have their work. They're given verbal and written reminders for two weeks. Still no work.
 - E.g.,; A student was absent when work was given. They were given verbal and written reminders for two weeks. Still no work.
- “BZ” grades are changed to “1” when final grades are due. Usually two weeks before the end of a semester.

Afternoon Dismissal

- Please pick up your child when coming to the playground immediately (if possible!)
 - For Health & Safety (so teachers know which students to monitor/observe)
- Please ensure you have authorised your child to be picked up by someone else by as soon as possible!
 - Our primary concern is that the school is responsible for ensuring every child goes home with the correct, authorised person
 - If someone unfamiliar tries to pick up a child without prior notice, it can raise safety flags and possibly delay dismissal
 - Health & Safety (as the teacher on duty may have to leave the field to speak to the school secretary)

Registered Childcare Duty Days

During registered childcare duty days, there are no didactic classes. We strongly encourage you to allow the student to take this well deserved break and have the chance to relax and unwind, which is essential for their mental well-being and overall health.

This is an important time for students to rest and recharge after a busy academic period.
