What We Learned...

September 2025

Language Arts

4th grade students began the first unit of the Cornerstone textbook titled "Animals, People, and Caring". They read stories about how animals take care of their young, and the importance of volunteering to help the environment.

They began reading their first novel, Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing. They have been reading mostly in partners and they work together on a weekly miniquiz on the chapter they read each week related to comprehension and vocabulary.

Mathematics

Students started off the year by reviewing their multiplication and division facts from last school year. We have been working on subraction and addition of 3-4 digit numbers.

Science

4th grade students set out to the school grounds on a discovery mission. They searched for living, non-living, once-living, and man-made objects. They uncovered what all living things have in common and learnt to tell apart herbivores, carnivores, and omnivores.

History

Students are working on learning historical chronology terms. We created a timeline of human history to practice putting events in order, and we are continuing to differentiate years, decades, and centuries.
