What We Learned...

October 2025

Language Arts

Students are in the last couple of chapters of the first novel! They have been working hard on writing summaries and making predictions during their mid-book review. As they finish the book they will start a cereal box book report to further summarize the rest of the story. They are working on Unit 2 in their Cornerstone book and it is all about natural disasters! They have been very excited to write about crazy weather events each day and to create spooky decorations.

Mathematics

Students have been working on using different strategies to solve multiplication word problems. They are learning how to identify the operation needed, and plan how to solve them.

Science

We've begun our unit on maps and directions. Students practiced the cardinal directions with a movement game. They followed a series of instructions with directions that surprisingly brought them back to their starting point. Students also practiced taking notes and giving directions using a map.

History

Students wrapped up their unit on historical chronology with a dance party and through the decades. Our next unit is on family history where they have started interviewing family members and they will build a personal family tree.
