What We Learned...

October 2025

Language Arts

Students are working diligently on vocabulary and academic terms. They created word searches using spelling words and continue to practice. They are currently on the second unit of the Keystone books and are focused on the big question: How does growing up change us? Students have written dialogues and informal letters. They are working on identifying and using figurative language including: similes, metaphors, hyperboles, personification and others.

Mathematics

Students finished a unit on the order of operations. They have been reviewing area and perimeter, and are practicing using the concepts in real-world examples of word problems.

Science

Sixth graders explored what animals eat and learned to identify carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores. Each student created a brochure about an animal of their choice, researching its diet, whether it is a vertebrate or invertebrate, and its animal classification. They also included fun facts and added wonderful drawings to bring their projects to life!

History

We finished learning about the Renaissance Period in Europe, and are now working on the Reformation. Students are preparing for a role play activity as members of the Council of Trent.
