What We Learned...

October 2025

Language Arts

Students are halfway through their first novel and have been working very hard in literature circles to discuss their questions, comprehension, reflections, and vocabulary in small groups. They have completed a mid-book quiz, and will be working on an assignment to dissect plot points and central ideas of the book. Students are on the second unit of their Keystone Book. This unit's main question is where can a journey take you? Students will read about migrations, leaving home, and returning home.

Mathematics

Students have been completing a project to design their own zoo. During the project, they have been reviewing area and perimeter of different shapes, and calculating costs associated with each exhibit.

Science

In October, 7th graders explored the human skin system. They began by comparing human skin and an onion, observing similarities and differences in their structure. Students also took part in role-playing activities, assessing a "patient" with skin issues and suggesting better hygiene habits.

History

Students learned about the industrial revolution and its effects on our world today. They are now working on individual mini-presentations about the Spring of Nations. Students were assigned one of four revolutions to learn about and explain to their classmates.
