What We Learned...

January 2026

Language Arts

Students have been reviewing words for the upcoming Spelling Bee in March. We have been exploring possessive adjectives and long vowel rules while writing letters to a friend using an example from Unit 3 of their Cornerstone books. Students have begun peer reviewing their first drafts together using a checklist. We are continuing to read the novel *Stuart Little*, and work on vocabulary and comprehension.

Mathematics

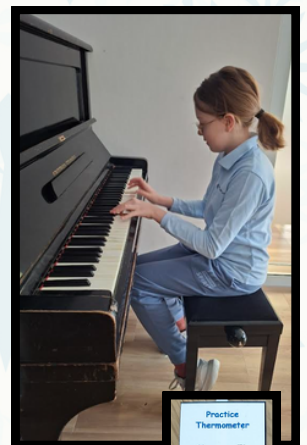
Students have been working on using protractors to measure angles. Students have been practicing identifying and naming types of angles, lines, rays, and segments.

Science

We covered topics on density and temperature. Students built their own thermometers, which will help them practice reading and interpreting temperature measurements. We played a bingo game to help students distinguish between animal hibernation, migration, and adaptation during the winter season.

History

Students completed a short research assignment about New Year's traditions in other countries. We also finished learning about why symbols are important to a country.
