Introduction

Language Arts

We finished the previous unit by writing descriptive paragraphs and practicing adjectives. We read stories in class including fairy tales, legends and picture books. We practiced as a class for the Spelling Bee, using this time to review vocabulary. We also got assigned our first book of the semester, "Nate the Great"

Mathematics

In math Grade 1 continued to explore 2D and 3D shapes. We also learned directional phrases and how to describe relationships between objects. Students also worked on word problems.

Social Studies

In our lessons students were writing, speaking and reading about their feelings on the first day of school. We also talked about friendships they have with others and how different people help each other in our community. Students started to learn about different aspects of a small city, a larger town and how to read a map..

Science

In science we learned about states of matter and how materials can change between a liquid, solid and gas. We also started to explore where energy comes from and how energy can be transferred in our environment. We learned about composting, recycling and how to reuse materials for a better world.

Art
