What We Learned...

February 2026

Language Arts

Students finished the third unit in the Cornerstone Books and started the 4th Unit about problem solving. Students are thinking about problems they have in or out of school that they experience, and they are creating advertisements for a product that solves it. Students are in the last few chapters of *Stuart Little*. They have been completing their chapter reading packets, and finish the book very soon!

Mathematics

Students have started a new unit on fractions. They started by learning about equivalent fractions. They are currently working on adding and subtracting, and simplifying their answers.

Science

Students explored density by creating colorful "liquid rainbows" using sugar solutions. We also began a new unit on land and water forms, building key vocabulary through a definition and picture matching activity.

History

Students have been analyzing maps and pictures as though they are cartographers and historians by asking many questions. We took some polls of the class to create graphs, identify trends in interests, and compare themselves to other groups of kids.
