What We Learned...

February 2026

Language Arts

We finished up the third unit in the Cornerstone Books and worked on creating original and collaborative skits in groups about life in the future. We wrote brochures about different types of technology in the classroom. Students began unit four and created informational posters about their favorite wild animals. They wrote essays comparing and contrasting two things.

Mathematics

Students wrapped up their unit on fractions with a focus on converting between mixed numbers and improper fractions. They are now working on identifying angles and their relationships.

Science

Students completed mini research posters on how bacteria impact human life, including their roles in soil formation, food production, and disease. They also examined the beneficial and harmful effects of protists and began studying the Fungi Kingdom with an experiment involving growing mold on food.

History

Students have been learning about the Middle Ages. They are wrapping up their unit by completing a two part project, where they chose if they wrote, drew, or constructed architecturally and culturally important parts of Medieval life.
