

## Malta 2026 – „20 000 Leagues Under the Sea”



Date: **22-26.09.2026**  
(Tuesday – Saturday)

Place: **Malta, Bugibba**  
Accommodation: 3-star hotel with a swimming pool



“Twenty Thousand Leagues Under the Sea” is a language workshop conducted entirely in English, taking place in the very heart of the seaside town of Bugibba in Malta.

The aim of the program is to explore the island and discover its lesser-known corners. Each participant will keep a travel journal featuring the most interesting Maltese discoveries and unforgettable memories.

Based on these experiences, a “Guide to Malta Through a Teenager’s Eyes” will be created.

### Programme and topics :

**Exploring the island** – these are trips around the island that allow participants to discover Malta. Our expeditions will be documented with photo sessions, and we will keep careful notes of everything we see. We will explore Maltese streets on foot, while traveling between locations by coach hired exclusively for our group.

**Discovering local cuisine** – culinary journeys in search of local flavors and dishes found only in this region. Daily lunches will be an opportunity to try unusual meals and award “stars” to local restaurateurs.

**Interesting people in Malta** – conversations with island residents during which participants will compare life on the mainland and on an island. Together, they will discuss various aspects of life in Malta, including opportunities and curiosities connected with this unique part of the world.

**Editing the journal** – careful note-taking, drawing, and processing the results of our trips. These activities will help participants select the information they have gathered, perform basic photo and material editing, and create a one-of-a-kind guide to the island. The guide will be published in print after the trip is completed.

### Where are we going?

We will stay in the picturesque town of Bugibba, located in the northern part of Malta, on St. Paul’s Bay, directly on the Mediterranean Sea.

### What meals will be provided?

Meals will be very tasty and varied. Two meals a day—breakfast and dinner—will be served buffet-style and prepared at the hotel. **Lunch will be paid for individually** and enjoyed at Maltese restaurants.

### Travel – how will we get to Malta?

We will fly to Malta with LOT Polish Airlines from Warsaw Chopin Airport.

**22.09.2026:** departure from Warsaw at 14:05; arrival in Malta at 17:10 (LO673)

**26.09.2026:** departure from Malta at 18:05; arrival in Warsaw at 21:00 (LO674)

Each participant must have a valid document authorizing entry to Malta – a national ID card from a European Union country or a passport.

### Program includes:

- Communication in English
- Implementation of a travel journal project in English
- Educational and exploratory land excursions conducted in English by local guides: Valletta, Bugibba, Marsaxlokk, Rabat, Mdina, the Three Cities
- A cruise on the Mediterranean Sea (the islands of Gozo and Comino, with relaxation at the Blue Lagoon)
- Discovering marine flora and fauna at the Malta National Aquarium
- Swimming in the warm sea and the hotel swimming pool
- And many more...

### Trip conditions – what is included in the price?

- Accommodation in a three-star hotel
- Meals: two meals a day (breakfast and dinner served buffet-style)
- Transport: flights
- Luggage: 1 carry-on bag (up to 8 kg) + 1 checked bag (up to 23 kg)
- Airport transfers in Malta (from the airport to the hotel and from the hotel to the airport)
- Private coach for excursions throughout the entire stay in Malta
- Program implementation, entrance tickets, and guides
- PZU insurance: medical expenses (KL) – PLN 300,000; accident insurance (NNW) – PLN 100,000; third-party liability (OC) – PLN 100,000



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### What are the financial conditions of the trip?

#### Price:

Price: PLN 3,495 + EUR 350 – valid for a group of 30 participants (4 supervisors)

Price: PLN 3,795 + EUR 400 – valid for a group of 20–29 participants (3 supervisors)

### Payment schedule

**Installment 1** – PLN 500 – by 15.02.2026 (confirmation of participation and flight ticket reservation)

**Installment 2** – PLN 1,000 – by 10.04.2026

**Installment 3** – PLN 1,000 – by 15.06.2026

**Installment 4** – remaining amount by 25.08.2026

**Installment 5** – payment in euros – cash payment on the day of departure at the airport

### Other important information for parents:

#### Travel documents

- Each trip participant must have a valid travel document: an ID card or a passport
- Each participant must have an EHIC card (European Health Insurance Card) – please ensure the EHIC card is obtained no later than 15 September
- For non-EU citizens, a visa or another travel document is required in accordance with the applicable regulations between countries

### Pocket money

Lunch is not included in the trip price and is paid for by the participants (the cost of one lunch is EUR 10–15).

The suggested amount of pocket money is approximately EUR 100–150.

### Cancellation terms for parents

In the event of cancellation, regardless of the reason, all paid installments are forfeited in favor of the organizer.

The price does not include insurance covering the costs of trip cancellation due to illness, accident, etc. Such insurance can be purchased from any insurance company within 7 days of the date of the first payment.

#### Day 1 – Hello Malta!

11:30 – meeting at the airport

- boat transfer from Gozo to Comino
