What We Learned...

March 2026

Language Arts

Students wrapped up their second novel, *A Wrinkle in Time* in time by completing a final project of their choice. They were able to complete an essay, or a one pager – a collage of themes, pictures, and quotes. In their Keystone books, they have begun creating advertisements to present about a product they would invent, and they are continuing to practice homophones and literary devices. Students began reading and discussing their third novel, *The Outsiders*.

Mathematics

Students have been solving expressions and equations with exponents. They have learned the four exponent rules, and have been practicing applying them to given expressions.

Science

We wrapped up the respiratory system unit. Students measured their lung capacity using balloons and explored why results varied. We also discussed respiratory diseases and compared healthy lungs with those of smokers.

History

Students learned about the effects of World War 1. They have been working in groups to research and present about events and people who were essential in the lead up to World War 2; with particular focus on Germany, Italy, and the Soviet Union.
