What We Learned...

April 2026

Language Arts

Students are a third of the way through Charlotte's Web, and they have been working on identifying character traits and practicing point of view. They have been practicing identifying main idea and supporting details in short texts, and Unit 5 of the Cornerstone Book. The students worked hard on preparing their Speaking Contest presentations and speeches. They did an incredible job!

Mathematics

Students have been working on adding and subtracting decimals. We competed in a team relay-race to answer the questions correctly first, and answered word problems around the room.

Science

Students began a unit on water by conducting experiments on dirty water filtration and desalination. They explored the water cycle by 'becoming' water particles and tracing their journey using colored beads to create keychains and bracelets. Adding a creative touch, they built mini dioramas of wetland ecosystems.

History

Students completed a research project on a person of their choice from Polish history. They were asked to write a historical narrative as a poem, interview, or presentation. They dressed up and presented at the end of the month.
