What We Learned...

April 2026

Language Arts

Students have been reading a different type of fairytale in their novel, *A Tale Dark and Grimm*. They have created a How-To Instruction sheet using imperative sentences, and learned how to write a formal e-mail. They are working on unit 5 in the Keystone books all about how courage and imagination are linked. They have spent several lessons preparing for the Speaking Contest and presented their work in front of their classmates. They did a wonderful job.

Mathematics

Students worked on exponents and square numbers. Then they started learning about nets of shapes and surface area of cubes and prisms.

Science

Students began learning about the five groups of vertebrates. While studying fish, they explored body shapes by creating models. The amphibian life cycle was brought to life through an interactive movement game, allowing students to progress through each stage.

History

Students learned about the French Revolution and Napoleon's transition to power. They have been working on creating presentations about each of the Napoleonic Wars that they will share with the class.
