What We Learned...

Language Arts

Students started their final book, *The Outsiders*. Throughout the book they have been working on vocabulary, character traits, plot events, comparing and contrasting, and character development. Students started Unit 5 of the Keystone book, to answer the question, why do we explore new frontiers? They have been working hard on preparing their speaking contest presentations. They did a wonderful job.

Mathematics

Students wrapped up a unit on exponent rules and began learning about square roots and cube roots. They have been working on using these within the order of operation.

Science

Grade 7 students explored nutrition by comparing food labels and learning how to make healthy choices. They also played a computer game where they planned daily meals that meet nutritional needs. In addition, they studied the organs of the digestive system and their functions by building creative models using materials available in the classroom.

History

Students researched and created presentations about Europe in the time between the World Wars. They learned about cultural revolutions of the 20s and 30s, and are currently preparing projects about the history of cinema around the world.
