What We Learned...

Language Arts

Students wrapped up their fifth unit of the Cornerstone book about housing around the world, by hosting a talk show about their unique, famous homes. Students are working hard to finish their 3rd book, Charlotte's Web, and completing their novel study packets. They have been enjoying reading outside with partners this month.

Mathematics

Students learned how to find the area and perimeter of rectangles and squares. They also learned how to convert units of measurement in the metric system.

Science

Students learned about lakes and rivers and practiced organizing information using tables. They also investigated the types of soil found in the school garden. In another activity, students explored how erosion and weathering affect rocks by using a cookie as a model.
