What We Learned...

May 2026

Language Arts

Grade 6 students have been working steadily to finish unit five in the Keystone books. We have completed our fable project and were able to read student stories to younger kids at the other school. We wrote short plot summaries and read them out loud in class. Students worked in groups to research and write about Nobel Peace Prize winners. Students also finished all their novel work and concluded reading *A Tale Dark and Grimm*.

Mathematics

Students learned about 3D geometric shapes and how to find surface area and volume. They created a backstory of a city they own, and then built it from the shapes they learned about.

Science

Students learned about mammals and explored the differences between a dolphin, a water-dwelling mammal, and a fish such as a shark. To summarize the vertebrate unit, students created Venn diagrams comparing two vertebrate groups and played a Taboo style animal guessing game.

History

Students created and presented their presentations about the Napoleonic Wars. Each group was given one of the first six Coalitions, and we did a review after of the top 3 facts of each coalition and overview of the seventh.
