What We Learned...

Language Arts

Grade 8 students completed the fifth unit in the Keystone books and began unit 6 which asks how the sky influences us. They summarized the purpose of each of the short stories and connected their lessons to the big question. Students worked to review for the grade eight exams and took time to review reported and quoted speech. They used quotation marks correctly and practiced using the present and past perfect tense.

Mathematics

Grade 8 students completed their Math Exams and have been doing reviews of the school year.

Science

Students investigated the impact of climate change on our planet by researching NASA satellite images. They compared before and after images to identify visible effects of climate change. They also completed a research project on extinct species to discover the causes of their extinction.
